Passage 1 Let's consider the hypothetical case of a physician who has been prescribing a variety of drugs for patients with high blood pressure. He has read about each in the medical literature, and has also recently seen articles about calcium channel blockers. But he realizes that he has only an impressionistic sense of how well the medications he currently uses are functioning; adding one more may well create more confusion than anything else. However, he certainly does not want to discount any new drug which may aid his patients. He realizes that laboratory studies, while obviously significant, are not the same as systematic observation of what is happening to his own patients. What he really wants to know is how the drugs he is currently using are affecting his patients, so he can draw some of his own conclusions about whether any one of the medications was more effective, and if so, in what specific context.
